Looking sharp! Cheerful sharpeners in new designs

Children love nothing more than taking things into their own hands and changing them. If their favourite pencil is blunt, they want to be able to solve the problem quickly. This is why they should have a sharpener in their pencil cases. Faber-Castell now offers these useful little tools in a range of new variants:

There is the double sharpener made from plastic with animal motifs. Many will already be familiar with the parrotfish. Eagles and ladybirds have now been added. And the best bit: the animal's cute nose is really an eraser. If you take the eraser off, you'll see a double sharpener for standard, jumbo and coloured pencils behind it.

Sharpeners with motifs reflecting current trends are new to the range: cupcakes, computer game monsters and graphical squares that look like they're from another, virtual world. Here, too, a double sharpener for various types of pencil sits underneath the eraser.

Finally, there is the miniature sharpener/eraser combination. The transparent box has only one sharpener for standard pencils; the white eraser is protected by a cap. When it comes to colours, Rainbow Pink, Sky Blue and Grass Green mean there's something for every child in the mix.
